A confidential computer-based system that helps you and your doctor keep track of your immunization history







WHAT IS LINKS?

LINKS is a statewide computer-based system designed to keep track of immunization records for your patients. Records from multiple providers will consolidate into one comprehensive record.

This web application allows doctors, nurses and other health professionals to search for their patients' vaccination records in a central location. In addition, authorized users can add and edit patient records and vaccination records, as well as maintain facility, physician, and lot number data.

HOW CAN I BENEFIT FROM LINKS?

- If you move within Louisiana, any participating provider in the state can retrieve your records
- LINKS reduces the chances of having the wrong immunization given due to incomplete records
- Get easy access to records needed for school, work and volunteer opportunities
- Receive automatic reminders to help keep you and your family's immunizations on schedule

- If your provider participates in LINKS, you will be automatically enrolled
- LINKS is used to record immunization records only and will not be utilized for marketing purposes
- You may choose only to share your records with your doctor and local parish health unit
- LINKS is completely confidential and secure
