The Louisiana Office of Public Health Immunization Program wishes to remind all VFC Providers of the federally-mandated MAXIMUM amount you are allowed to charge VFC-eligible patients for administration of vaccines.

- A provider must not charge a vaccine administration fee that exceeds the administrative fee cap of \$21.30 per vaccine dose to non-Medicaid VFC-eligible children. The non-Medicaid VFC-eligible categories of children are Uninsured, Underinsured, and American Indian/Alaska Native.
- For Medicaid VFC-eligible children, accept the reimbursement for immunization administration set by the state Medicaid agency or the contracted Medicaid health plans.
- The administration fee is charged per vaccine and not per antigen in vaccine.
- A provider must not deny administration of a federally purchased vaccine to a patient if the patient's family cannot afford to pay the administrative fee.
